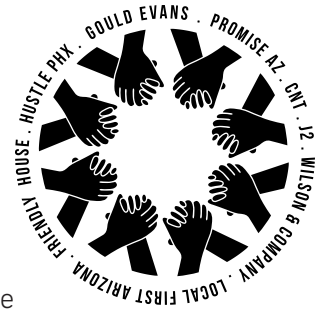


DID YOU KNOW...



Improving Regional Access is a goal within the South Central Corridor community that we have learned about through our outreach. Regional Access is the increased ability to use the broader community and metropolitan area resources.

GOALS FOR REGIONAL ACCESS

- Current transit service allows up to 90,000 potential customers to reach South Central Corridor retail within a 30 minute or less bus ride. **Increasing access to the community can result in additional dollars coming in to benefit the South Central Corridor community as a whole.**
- There is a shortage of critical amenities, business and entertainment types in the community. **By planning your community and supporting the growth of local businesses, South Central can become a community destination with critical and accessible amenities for all.**
- Current travel times to many job centers from the South Central Corridor are long, and current transit services can be infrequent. **Working with transit authorities to add transit types and increase the frequency and hours of availability of connections can help make travel more enjoyable, affordable, and an efficient alternative to cars.**
